- 1 **Standard VHS format**—This can be viewed on a VCR.
- 2 **Standard DVD format**—This can be viewed with a DVD player.
- 3 **MPEG 1 format on a CD disc**—This can be viewed by a computer equipped with a CD drive and *Windows Media Player software or software of that type*. One CD can hold up to 1 hour of video. MPEG 1 is used with most trial presentation software (i.e. Sanction, Trial Director, etc.) and is the standard media for video playback by Gore Brothers.
- 4 **MPEG 1 format on a DVD disc**—This can be viewed on a computer equipped with a DVD/CD drive and *Windows Media Player software or software of that type*. One DVD can hold up to 6 hours of video. MPEG 1 is used with most trial presentation software. (i.e. Sanction, Trial Director, etc.) and is the **standard** media for video playback by Gore Brothers.
- 5 **MPEG 2 format on a DVD disc**—This can be viewed on a computer equipped with a DVD drive and *Windows Media Player software or software of that type*. It is also compatible with most stand-alone DVD players and will hold up to 2 hours of video.  
Note: This format is not compatible with trial presentation software, but can be edited.
- 6 **Video Synchronization on a DVD disc**—This format allows you to view the synchronized transcript with the video on a computer equipped with a DVD drive. An example of this would be YesLaw.
